SCHOOLS FILM COMPETITION

Reconciliation SA encourages First Nation and non-First Nation students to work together in producing a film that embraces the theme of Reconciliation week 2021 **"More than words – Reconciliation takes action"**.

Age: Reception – year 12 - teams of First Nation and non- First Nation students working together.

Theme: "More than words – Reconciliation takes action"

Length: 3 – 5 minutes

WHAT CAN BE FUNDED

Applicants for this competition will assist their school in undertaking activities that:

- provide opportunities for First Nation and non- First Nation peoples to come together in shared learning opportunities.
- contribute to ongoing positive relationships between First Nation peoples and the education community.
- increase opportunities to First Nations cultural appreciation activities within the learning environment.
- ensuring that First Nation and non- First Nation peoples are involved in the planning, design, and delivery of the multimedia production.
- Encourage students to be creative with their multimedia productions for example time lapses, songs, animation, dance.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this funding you must be a South Australian:

- Department for Education Primary or Secondary School
- AISSA Primary or Secondary School
- CESA Primary or Secondary School

JUDGING CRITERIA

The panel will judge the film on the following criteria:

- Does the film meet entry requirements?
- Is there a clear vision and understanding of reconciliation in the film?
- Is the film original and creative?

WHAT IS THE PROCESS

Applications are open **Friday 16th April 2021** and close **Friday 21st May 2021**.

Applications can be made via the templated word document attached or you can go to our website www.reconciliationsa.org.au and complete the application online.

Your film will be judged by a panel selected by Reconciliation SA.

If it is unsuccessful, you will be notified in writing.

The Winner will be notified via email and will be announced **Friday 28th May**.
