How it will be judged

A judging panel will be formed to select the winners in each Artwork and Age Category. The judging panel will consist of:

- at least three First Nations and independent members
- one representative from Reconciliation SA
- one from the sponsoring body.

Artworks will be judged on the merit of the artwork entered combined with the artist statement showing its relevance to the 2022 theme for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Children's Day of "My Dreaming. My Future".
